Parking is the driveway and the parking lot across the street, 2 spots are behind the "Imperfect Perfection" home, 2 spots on the concrete pad at the "Studios", 2 spots on the concrete pad at "Blue with a View", and 1 on the concrete pad at the "Stilts" property. Additional parking is across the street in our parking lot. PLEASE do not park on the grass, asphalt (excluding at the Rose Cottage), or in the handicap parking spot by the pool (unless you are at the pool & have handicap parking certification displayed on tag or mirror). Violators are at risk of being towed and/or fined.

Instructions

Check-in is 4:00 PM (5:00 PM if you are booked between the last Saturday in May to the second Saturday in August) Central Time. For the main house there is a combination lock on back door which is accessible through side breezeway from driveway. Code for every home will be the last 4 digits of the cell number associated with the booking.

Also, check out is 10:00 AM (12:00 PM if you are booked between the last Saturday in May to the second Saturday in August) Central Time and unfortunately we have to be strict on this because we usually have groups coming in

the same day. You are welcome to hang out at the dock and beach area until early afternoon if that is desirable.

- 4. Towels can be just left on bathroom floors
- 5. Please do not launder any of our linens, unless during your stay you need to. The thought is appreciated but our standards are extremely high.
- 6. Please empty the fridges completely.
- 7. Put furniture back if you rearranged.
- 8. Please put games away. If you lost pieces please let us know so the next group can have complete games.
- 9. If you brought chalk for the kids, please wash off all of the beautiful artwork.
- 10. Give us a list if anything needs repairs. We would love to come during your visit if you see something that needs attention.
- 11. Turn thermostats to 68 in cooler weather and 74 in warm/hot days.
- 12. Lock all exterior doors upon departure.

Trash

Trash cans: located right outside of the Rose Cottage. Garbage is required to be bagged and tied and we do not have recycling. Tuesday is trash day so you may hear someone on side of house Monday late grabbing cans and then Tuesday putting garbage cans back. If you feel you may have excess trash, there is a dumpster on the way to the beach area where you can put trash into. If trash is left outside of the can you may have extra clean-up fees incurred as we are in the woods and animals WILL get any trash left outside a receptacle.

TV

Every TV is either a smart TV or ROKU so you will have access to Netflix, Hulu, etc.. Every TV except three also have Dish network with tons of channels!

PLEASE do not mess with any of the cords on the tv's/DVD players/Dish boxes. Failure to abide may result in reprogramming/recalibration charge if we have to diagnose and reset any of the tv's. We make sure every TV works prior to arrival so if any are inoperable please report immediately.

The back patio has a projector and the remote is by the light switches. It can be connected to via Bluetooth or HDMI. It also has a ROKU connected to it, so you can access streaming services.

Laundry

There is one washer and dryer in the garage area for the Main House & "The Den", One at "The Rose Cottage", one at the "Imperfect Perfection" home, one at the pool area, & one at "Blue with a View". We do provide detergent. Total: 5 W/D on property.



Pool

The pools are SO FUN but there are a few things you need to know:

- -Before entering the pools you will need to shower off, <u>especially if you have been in</u> the lake.
- -There is no glass allowed around the pool areas.
- -Pool hours are from 10 AM to 10 PM. Please let your guests know that it is very dangerous to swim outside of those parameters as the pool is sanitized with commercial shock at 10 PM. We do not want anyone to get chemically burned.
- -The Pool Season starts Memorial Day and ends Labor day but we can be lenient offseason. If you are booking outside of that time frame, and would like to swim, please let us know prior to arrival. With notice, you can choose to heat the pool to 85 degrees. It would be an additional payment of \$160 per day.
- -PLEASE do not park in the handicap parking spot by the pool (unless you are at the pool & have handicap parking certification displayed on tag or mirror). Violators are at risk of being towed and/or fined

LAKE:

- -The water around dock is not extremely deep. It is 4-5 feet deep around the dock so NO DIVING please. We definitely jump in but larger people will touch their feet to the bottom of lake.
- -We have provided kayaks, a canoe, and all sorts of floats. Check out the closet on the dock for floats, paddles, life vests and noodles.
- -Dock lights are in the closet to the left when you open. There are string lights and also a big light on the lake side of dock that may aid in night fishing.
- -We also have two volleyball nets at the beach, picnic tables, and chaise lounges. Volley ball, Frisbee's and sand toys are in the colored chest near the big tree at the beach. Pump is located in garage if you need to pump anything up with air.
- -There are coolers in the outdoor kitchen and even a 5 gallon beverage dispenser if you want to bring ice water down and keep it all day to stay hydrated. There is a ice machine located at the outdoor kitchen (not during winter months) & the coffee station. If you need more ice there is a commercial ice machine at the resort pool if you need to grab some from there. There is an ice caddy and a big white cooler for you to transport it.
- -PLEASE DO NOT BRING ANY GLASS DOWN TO THE WATER. If a glass breaks and lands on the beach or in the water, someone could get cut.
- -There are NO LIFEGUARDS on duty at the pool or the lake, swim at your own risk.

Hot Tub

!!!VERY IMPORTANT!!!

The hot tub is SO NICE, especially in cooler weather. There are a couple of things that will TRASH the hot tub for your stay so here are the remedies:

- Make sure you do not get any lake water in it. Please use the outdoor showers (not available during the winter) to wash off before entering the hot tub.
- Essential oils/Suntan lotions and oils. It seems to be popular for guests to want to put essential oils in the water. We appreciate the properties of those oils but it will trash your water. Please refrain from adding and definitely wash off if anyone has the oils of any kind on their bodies or swimsuits.

The hot tub at the main house & "Blue with a View":

- -The only buttons you need to press are the "Jets" button which has four clicks and settings and the other is "+ or -" buttons for the temperature. Our experience is that either kids are playing with the control panel or adults think they need to program but it can SO mess up the hot tub for your stay. We suggest using just the buttons listed above.
- -If you DO use it and you have more than a few people get in, please pour 1 baggie of granular chlorine (provided for you, located in the island drawer in the kitchen at the main house & in the master bedroom closet at the "Blue with a View home") into hot tub EVERY night when you are done for the day and do not enter until the following morning.
- -If the water gets below the jets, put water in it immediately. If the water is below the jets, it could burn the hot tub motor up. At the main house, there is a water hose in between the hot tub & the pool pump house. The hose is hooked up in the valve box. At the "Blue with a View" home, it is to the right of the hot tub.
- -Finally, enjoy it! So relaxing.

****On Friday's during peak season (last Saturday in May to the second Saturday in August) we will come to evaluate the condition of the hot tub at the main house & the "Blue with a View" home. If they need to be drained, we will drain them and they will be unavailable the remainder of your stay.

Grill

The main house, "The Rose Cottage", & "Blue with a View" all have a propane grill. Propane is provided, there are extra tanks in the garage if you run out. The "Imperfect Perfection", "Studios", & "Stilts" homes have a charcoal grill and charcoal is provided.

****On Friday's during peak season (last Saturday in May to the second Saturday in August) we will come to clean the main house grill. We will coordinate a time with you that is best to clean it. It will take us around an hour to clean and put back together. Wrellow)

Thermostat

The main house has 4 different wall thermostats, "The Rose Cottage" has one wall thermostat upstairs, and two mini splits downstairs that is controlled by two different remotes. "Imperfect Perfection" has one wall thermostat. "Studios" each have their own wall thermostat. "Blue with a View" has a thermostat upstairs and downstairs. "Stilts" home has two mini splits that are controlled by two different remotes. During summer months, be sure to close the curtains on the front of the main house to help control the temperature inside the home.

***Upon departure, turn thermostats to 68 in cooler weather and 74 in warm/hot days.

Fireplace

All of the fire pits OUTSIDE on the patios are propane. We strive to make sure they are full but if you run out, extra propane tanks are in the garage laundry room. PLEASE do not leave it on when not in use. Do not roast marshmallows over this fire, can be dangerous! We also have a wood burning fire area down by the lake, great for roasting marshmallows!

There are two wood fire pits down by the lake both on opposite ends of the volleyball court & one at the "Stilts" home. Wood is provided. In garage, & at each house there are kits for real wood-burning fires at the lake. Fire starter and skewers for s'mores.

The Stilts home has an electric fireplace and it is controlled by a remote. The "Imperfect Perfection" & "Blue with a View" home have a gas fireplace and it is controlled by an "ON/OFF" switch that is located directly in front of the logs.

What's provided

Replenish supplies: The house is well stocked for you. We have enough paper towels, napkins, bathroom tissue, trash bags and facial tissues for the duration of your stay. We also stock shampoo, body wash, conditioner and bar soap for our guests. Additionally we have dish soap and dishwasher detergent as well as laundry soaps and bleach. Even basic kitchen things like trash bags, foil and saran wrap. If you run out, call us to replenish. We'll be happy to.

Other

- -String Lights: The switch for the string lights on back patio of the main house are in a weird place. Sorry! It is on the side of the old barn you can see from the back door of the house and right beside the entrance to the den. Please turn them off when not in use.
- -Lights on the back patio: are on a timer to turn on at 8:30AM & off at 2AM. If you need them ON before or after those times:
- 1. Open the timer box (located on the wall where the projector projects to)
- 2. You will see "ON" on the right side. Just press the lever down that is above "ON" & they will turn on.
- **PLEASE DO NOT TOUCH THE TIMER WHEEL.

If you just want to dim them or turn them OFF, you will see the switches below the box & you can dim them there, all the way "OFF". They are labeled. If you dim them all the way off, you will need to be sure to increase the dimmer for the lights to work the next morning.

- -Outdoor fun: In addition to volleyball, we have two sets of corn hole, Beersbee, horseshoes, Ladder ball, Connect4, life size chess, and a giant Jenga for you to play. Some of these are located in the garage & others at the pool area. For the ones in the garage, play on grassy front lawn or down at the beach area. Please pack back up when done and retain all the pieces for the next guests to enjoy.
- -Outdoor Showers: are unavailable during winter months. BEFORE ARRIVAL we will be glad to dewinterize, if weather permits.
- Weight limits: The full size bunk beds have a weight limit of 250lbs up, 300 middle, 175 trundle. The twin metal bunk beds have a weight limit of 220lbs upper and lower.

In case you haven't noticed, it is our desire to hopefully allow you to just bring clothes and food! We feel like we "have thought of everything" for the house and we are experienced in these short term rentals. If there is something you need for daily living and it is not in the house, will you please let us know so we can consider bringing it to you?
